Justice reinvestment is a way of working that shifts power & decision making to First Nations communities to self-determine the best way to improve justice outcomes in place. Rather than just reacting with expensive measures like policing, prosecution, & prisons, justice reinvestment works to address the root causes of criminal behaviour & create thriving communities.

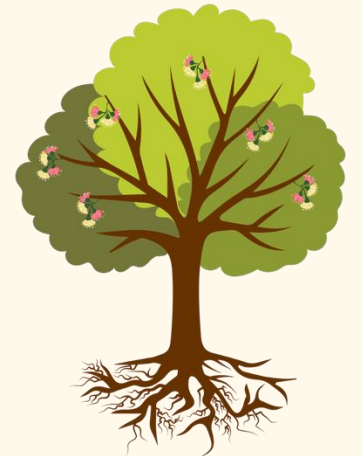
